


WILLIAMS CAFE BARISTA/STOCKER

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Serve customers at Williams Café in a cheerful, courteous, and dependable manner.
- Prepare coffee and espresso drinks according to training procedure.
- Accurately operate the cash register and credit card machines.
- Stock merchandise in the store and manage inventory in storage.
- Maintain the cleanliness of equipment and general café area according to health inspection policies.
- Respond promptly, usually within 24 hours, to all correspondence from agency management.
- Available for other duties as assigned.

Attendance Requirements:

- Monthly Hour-Long Agency Meetings (Determined by employee availability)
- On-time to scheduled shifts
- Minimum 50% of PSA GBM's (2 of 4 per semester)
